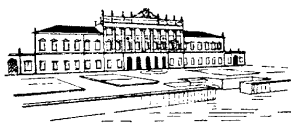

## **Topics**

## **General Information**

Attendance at the International Workshop, organized like a Round Table, is strictly on invitation to scholars and ex-governmental officials, and open to about 20 participants, chairpersons and speakers included.

The official language of the Workshop is English. Each session is coordinated by a Chairperson. Each speech is limited to no more than 10 minutes in order to leave enough time for the general discussion.

Officials at the Workshop can take part as observers in their personal capacities in order to encourage wide-ranging and uninhibited discussions among the experts.
